Discussion Sessions: Monday 25 January 2010

We would like to invite you to the political decision makers meeting of the *Soltrain [Solar Water Heating Training Initiative in Southern Africa]* sponsored by the Austrian Development Agency (ADA) in partnership with AEE Intec and local stakeholders on Monday 25 January 2010 in Cape Town at the Western Cape Government's Boardroom (see map below).

As a stakeholder in solar energy and someone who can influence policy in this regard you can make a major input to these two initiatives that form part of government policy in both South Africa and the neighbouring countries of Mozambique, Namibia and Zimbabwe. The training of producers, installers and maintainers of SWH in Southern Africa has been identified previously as one of the major barriers to large-scale implementation. Installers and maintainers constitute that part of the SWH value chain that carries least risk and capital investment and is therefore suitable for creating work opportunities for the Southern African region, especially in the current economic situation.

The morning session will be opened by Prof Wikus van Niekerk from the Centre of Renewable and Sustainable Studies, followed by a presentation showing the framework of the Soltrain project. Dr Werner Weiss will present a view of the international market. The post coffee session will cover the current status solar market in South Africa. The workshop will conclude with a discussion and recommendations for future political decisions.

The workshop will take place from 09h00 – 12h00 at the Western Cape Government's Boardroom, Ground Floor, Utilitas Building, 1 Dorp Street, Cape Town, South Africa. 
